Compton Pop-Up Library

We are delighted to confirm that the Parish Council has agreed to fund the pop-up library service in the village for the next year. This initiative will see a 90-minute visit each month at an annual cost of only £1,100. This funding decision, made through the reallocation of existing budget lines, highlights our commitment to enhancing our community and providing valuable new resources for all residents.

As we begin the new financial year, we are pleased to confirm that the required funding is now in place to commission the replacement of the remaining footway lights in our community. Although a specific work date has not yet been set by the contractor, please be assured that the project will commence soon.

We are pleased to confirm that the immersion heater in the sports pavilion has been successfully replaced. Unfortunately, we are likely to need to replace the water tank in the near future. We have secured the final funding required for new flooring - this project will be carried out over the summer break.
